When students take an active part in their community, they practice responsible citizenship. Our 8th grade students are expected to complete 20 hours of community service and 7th grade students are expected to complete 15 hours of community service, and 6th grade students are expected to complete 10 hours each school year. Students are responsible for maintaining records of their completed service and for obtaining signatures from sponsors of service experiences.

Students will be engaged in service learning experiences throughout the year as part of the curriculum, and they will be able to include these hours in their totals for the year.

Suggested service opportunities for individual or small groups of students will also be available during the year. There are numerous ways to perform service; however, simply attending a meeting with any group (Scouts, church, school, etc.), does not constitute service, unless that meeting directly involves the carrying out of the service. Completed service logs will be collected before the end of the year. Students are to complete a reflection sheet on each service experience and submit it to our community service coordinator. A copy of that sheet is included in this book and is available on our web site and in the front office at school.
