Item: Changes in Student/Athlete Eligibility
Date: March 30, 2016

As a participant in our athletic program at Beaufort Middle School, your student athlete has accepted the responsibility to comply with the following eligibility standards in regard to academic performance and behavior.

I. To have completed by his/her classroom teacher a weekly progress report to determine whether he/she is performing in a satisfactory or unsatisfactory manner academically in each class.

Note:

- Unsatisfactory for two consecutive weeks in a single subject or Unsatisfactory in two or more subjects during one week for academics will result in a suspension for 25% of the next contest. Student athletes who receive unsatisfactory marks must have their athletic progress report signed by their parent/guardian and their coach. Failure to do so will result in a suspension for 25% of the next contest.
- Multiple occurrences in the same class will result in mandatory tutoring during practice time and a suspension for 50% of the next contest. **(Times and days for tutoring will be determined by the Study Hall Coordinator and Athletic Director).**
- Failure to turn in an athletic progress report will result in suspension for 25% of the next contest. Failure to turn in multiple reports will result in a one game suspension.
- Forgery or alteration of an athletic progress report will result in a one week suspension from team activities.

II. To exhibit satisfactory behavior at all times in accordance with the policies of our school.

Note:

- Student athletes who receive Unsatisfactory for classroom behavior must have their athletic progress report signed by their parent/guardian and their coach. Failure to do so will result in a suspension for 25% of the next contest. Multiple occurrences will result in increased suspension and possible dismissal from the team.
- Three assignments to In School Suspension per athletic season will render the student athlete ineligible for one competition; also, an additional ISS assignment will result in another one game suspension with Principal review for future participation. Out of school suspension will result in one game suspension with Principal review for future participation.

Please review this information with your student. Then, sign and return this document to your student athlete's coach. We hope to make this a rewarding experience for our young people and look forward to a successful season and school year.
